Wandlebury Country Park is located off the A1307 between Cambridge and the A11. It is roughly 2 miles south of the edge of Cambridge.

There is a cycle path alongside the A1307 from Cambridge and bus stops outside the Park (serving Cambridge-Haverhill route).

If coming by car then the park can be accessed from either side of the dual carriageway and is signposted as “Wandlebury”.

Please park in the main visitor car park. Car parking fees are in operation so please leave a note on your dashboard to explain that you have a meeting.

To reach the Education Centre: From the main car park continue up the hill along the surfaced drive and follow it. You will go around a bend and over a small bridge. After the bridge turn right across the grass towards the low building, which is the Education Centre.
